

Paddington Academy | Yr11 Transition work

This work will take you at least 10 hours. Please read the whole sheet before starting.

1. Visit an [online gallery](#) and select 2 artworks that provoke a response in you.
 - a. Create 3 drawings of each selected artwork.
 - i. 1 drawing should be a quick 10-minute sketch
 - ii. 1 drawing should be a 30-minute sketch
 - iii. 1 drawing should be a 1-hour detailed drawing

Once you have drawn these, add annotation to explain why you chose the artwork and what thoughts have been provoked in you whilst drawing them. Beside the drawing, you must write the artist's name, title, date and medium.

2. Take a set of 5 high quality photographs in response to the ideas that interested you in the artists' work from the first task. They should be 5 different ideas and not 5 photographs of the same thing. This should take you about 1 hour.

Make sure you consider the following when taking your photographs:

- a. Background/setting
- b. Subject/main focus
- c. Composition
- d. Lighting
- e. Cropping

3. Create one sustained study or response either from 1 of your photographs or by combining 2 or more together (it can be a drawing, painting or a sculpture) in any medium that best suits the work. This should take you at least 4 ½ hours.
4. Self-reflection task: Write about which areas of your GCSE work you felt most proud and confident. What went really well? Write about which areas of your GCSE work you struggled with. Where do you need to improve for your AS? What is it that fascinates you and what would you like your art to be about? Add images to support your writing (minimum of 500 words). This should take you at least 30 minutes.
