**SUCCESS CRITERIA for each country**

1. Location of country (e.g. in the world, on continent)
2. Climate of country (including variation across the country)
3. Major cities / parts of the country (e.g. counties/regions)
4. Relief map of country (where are the mountains, flat areas?)
5. Development of the country – how has this changed?
6. Physical challenges facing the country (earthquakes, volcanoes, tsunamis, hurricanes, droughts)
7. Human challenges facing the country (economic change, population, energy, political, war)

**Don't worry, you're not presenting them to the class (unless you want to!)**

BUT please consider how it looks, as that's just as important as the information on it!
