Free School Meals

The Government has agreed to provide support so that those children that usually receive Free School Meals will continue to do so. We have decided to do this in the form of an electronic voucher for Sainsburys to the value of £20 a week for each of the next two weeks.

What is an e-voucher?

It is a link that when it is clicked on has a barcode that can be scanned in a shop and will be worth the amount of £20 towards a shopping bill. Sainsbury's on Harrow Road is the supermarket closest to the school and this is why we chose this supermarket.

How will the voucher be sent?

The voucher will be sent to your child's school email address. The reason we have to send it to your child is that this is the only secure method where we know that the email is sent to the correct child, as lots of parent email addresses we hold are out of date

How do I access the voucher?

If you have your child's email on your phone, you can easily bring it up in the shop on a smartphone. Alternatively, you can get your child to forward the email to your phone/email. You could print the voucher too.

When will I receive the voucher?

By the end of today, it should be sent to your child. You will receive another voucher next week also. After this is the Easter holidays, so you would not receive Free School Meals during this period.

What will happen after the Easter holidays?

The Government have promised to put a national scheme in place so you should not need to receive a voucher. If the scheme is not in place, then we will contact you again.
